**What Is MATHCOUNTS?**

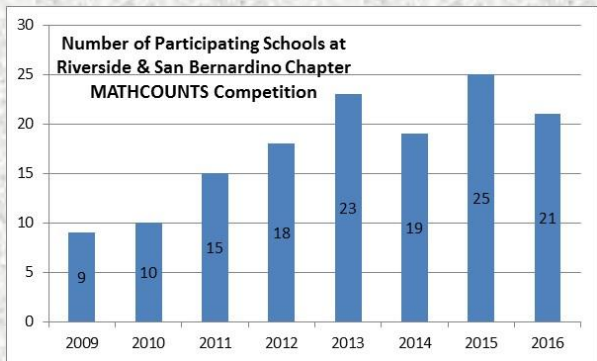
MATHCOUNTS is a national enrichment, club and competition program that promotes middle school mathematics achievement through grassroots involvement in every U.S. state and territory. Participants advance through School, Chapter and State Competitions until the final 228 students (Mathletes) are selected from fifty-seven states and territories to advance to the MATHCOUNTS National Competition held each May.



**MATHCOUNTS In Riverside/San Bernardino**

Since 2009, California Baptist University’s College of Engineering has hosted the Riverside/San Bernardino Chapter Competition. The College of Engineering offers \$10,000 (\$2,500/year) scholarship for the top performers who attend CBU’s College of Engineering full time in the future. CBU's College of Engineering students volunteer their time to help the event as competition proctors and graders.

Dr. Ziliang Zhou, Professor and Chair of Mechanical Engineering, is the co-coordinator for the chapter competition. Dr. Zhou is also a board member of the California Society of Professional Engineers Education Foundation (CSPEEF), which sponsors local and State MATHCOUNTS competitions.
